General Business	<p>There was recently an inappropriate post with a photo of a person was posted on BRA Facebook page. It was taken down within an hour, but has prompted a review of policies and procedures wrt posts.</p> <p>The purpose of the BRA Facebook page is community engagement. It is not a way to make complaints. Council deals with barking dogs, roaming animals. Police deal with property damage, noise, speeding.</p> <p>Guidelines were discussed and endorsed including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Only uncontroversial matters to be posted eg lost pets. * No photos / videos of people, houses. * No identifying information to be posted, including car number plates, addresses, names; * Serial offenders will be blocked; <p>The exception is raising awareness of NHW matters that potentially concern local residents eg house break-ins, but only after police have been notified, and no specific address, just a an area within Bunya, e.g. Downs, Windarra.</p> <p>The Guidelines will be pinned at top of the BRA Facebook page so all potential users are aware of policy. Moderator will continue to monitor and post only appropriate items on BRA Facebook page.</p>	Facebook activity and functionality of Guidelines to be reviewed in 6 months
